

# Go green

## Getting to the UK

### Train

You can go by direct train to London St Pancras (which is next to King's Cross, for trains to York) from Brussels, Lille and Paris.

### Coach

You can go by coach to London direct from many European cities.

### Boat

You can go by boat from Zeebrugge or Rotterdam to Hull (about 35 miles/56 km), or from Amsterdam to Newcastle (about 75 miles/120 km). Both are overnight crossings. You can go by foot, or take your car.

### Air

You can fly to the following airports in the North of England from lots of European cities, including:

- **Leeds-Bradford** (bus to Leeds, then train to York)
  - **Austria** (Salzburg), **Belgium** (Brussels), **Germany** (Dusseldorf), **Netherlands** (Amsterdam), **Poland** (Krakow)

# Getting to York

You can go by train or coach to York from all over the UK. The train is quicker, the coach is cheaper.

## Train

There are regular **direct** trains to York from Bristol, Doncaster, Glasgow, Hull, Leeds, London (King's Cross), Manchester Airport and Newcastle.

## Coach

You can get a coach from most cities and airports, but you may have to change to get to York.

# Getting from York to Rufforth

## Bus

correct up to 31<sup>st</sup> May, but likely to be similar in August

### Which bus?

412 / 413 (York<>Wetherby bus)

### Where?

York Railway station (stop H) <> Rufforth Airfield (between the villages of Acomb and Rufforth)

### How long does it take?

less than 15 minutes

### When?

1 bus every hour on Friday, Saturday and Monday. (No bus on Sunday)

Monday-Friday

first from York at 07.47 – last from York at 18.42

first from Rufforth at 07.19 – last from Rufforth at 18.56

Saturday

first from York at 07.57 – last from York at 18.42

first from Rufforth at 09.41 – last from Rufforth at 18.46

### How much does it cost?

about £2.40 each way

## Taxi
